Credit Enhancement Program

- Allows students to take extra credits and courses that may not be offered at their school to either recover lost credits or enhance their academic status using Education 2020 software.
- Private and school funded
- \$90 per half credit hour
- Capacity of 6

Day Treatment

- Community-based program intended to prevent repeat offenses and out-of-home placement for children who have been adjudicated. Supervision is provided during after-school hours. This seven-day-a-week program allows children to participate in daily group meetings using a positive youth development model.
- Court funded
- Referrals must come through a court order from a judge or referee
- Capacity of 12

Juvenile Diversion Program

- Allows non-violent, first-time offenders or students with delinquency issues to avoid making similar mistakes, while improving behaviorally, socially and academically.
- Private and court funded
- A non-refundable fee of \$100 is due the first week of class
- Capacity of 120 per year

Suspension Center

- Students are provided with a supervised academic setting where they can continue their school assignments during an out-of-school suspension.
- School funded
- \$40 per day, per student
- Capacity of 24
